The **CETP Refresher** class will refresh your knowledge of the important concepts and tasks covered in Basic Principles and Practices of Propane. It also includes new information added to the course.

CETP Refresher will build on the previous curriculum to provide updates on codes, standards, regulations and state law. We will revisit basic concepts and review any important safety, equipment or operational developments.

The source module and lesson from the full course will be identified for each topic covered. Note that not all modules and lessons in the full course are covered in refresher training.
