The Basic Plant Operations course provides information, practices, and procedures to safely and efficiently perform bulk plant operations tasks, mainly cylinder inspection, filling and requalification, and plant and equipment maintenance.

The topics covered are:

- Main components of a bulk plant.
- Propane liquid supply system.
- Inspection and filling of DOT cylinders.
- Inspection and filling of vehicle mounted ASME tanks.
- DOT cylinders visual inspection and requalification.
- Maintaining cylinders and ASME tanks.
- Unloading cargo tank motor vehicles.
- Bulk plant systems and equipment maintenance.

Copies of NFPA 58, the LP-Gas Code, are available for purchase separately. See accompanying brochure for order information or call MPGA.

What to expect: Students will take quizzes and tests to assess their pace of learning. A multiple-choice test will be administered at the end of the class.

Tests are graded by a third party and the results are mailed to each company. A score of 70% or higher is required to pass the test.
